Conservation corner

This little Firecrest was spotted and photographed by NSL birding in the village last month. They are one of the smallest birds in the UK, sometimes weighing as little as 5 grams.

Firecrests are very rare in the UK with only 550 known breeding pairs. They have a completely insectivorous diet and prefer a forest habitat, although if you are very lucky, they may visit your garden.

Bristol Airport Expansion

Bristol Airport are expecting an increase from 10 million passengers per annum (mppa) to 12mppa in the mid 2020s and rising to 20mppa by the mid-2040s. This expansion will mean more air traffic, building additional car parking and runways on the green belt and more road traffic past Newton St Loe and through Corston.
